PRODUCT WARRANTY INFORMATION

Thank you for choosing Fraser Engine Rebuilder, Inc. We appreciate your business and your trust in our products and customer service. This document outlines the warranty coverage for your recent purchase. Please retain this information for your records.

Important Warranty Information

Warranty Commencement

Your warranty begins either on the date of installation or 10 days after the original purchase date--whichever comes first. Coverage duration depends on the product type (see Warranty Options section).

Warranty Registration

Product registration is required for warranty coverage. Instructions are on page 9. Failure to register may void the warranty.

What Is Covered

This warranty covers defects in material and workmanship of the product only. It excludes damage to the equipment in which the product is installed and any indirect expenses (e.g., towing, lodging, storage). Your sole remedy is the repair or replacement of the product.

Maintenance Responsibilities

Proper maintenance using parts that meet engineering specifications is required. Failure to follow the maintenance schedule may void your warranty.

Warranty Options and Terms

Refer to your invoice to determine your applicable warranty coverage.

Remanufactured Engines

- Standard: 3-Year, Unlimited Miles (Parts & Labor, \$50/hr reimbursement)
- Fraser ADVANTAGE(TM): 5-Year, Unlimited Miles (Parts & Labor, \$50/hr reimbursement)
- Diesel & High Performance: 1-Year, Unlimited Miles (Parts & Labor, \$50/hr reimbursement)

No-Fault Warranty (NFW) Upgrades

- 3-Year/Unlimited Miles: \$249 -- One-time free replacement regardless of cause
- 5-Year/Unlimited Miles: \$349 -- One-time free replacement regardless of cause

Note: NFW plans must be purchased at the time of sale. Valid only if installed by a LARF. Coverage ends after the first denied claim.

Labor Reimbursement Tiers

(Replacements only. Other repairs: \$50/hr based on AllData book time.)

- \$149 Plan -- Max payout: \$800
- \$249 Plan -- Max payout: \$1,100
- \$349 Plan -- Max payout: \$1,400
- \$449 Plan -- Max payout: \$1,600
- \$549 Plan -- Max payout: \$1,900
- \$899 Plan -- Max payout: \$2,300

Warranty Coverage and Exclusions

Fraser Engine Rebuilder, Inc. will repair or replace defective parts due to material or workmanship issues. Domestic shipping is included.

Not Covered (Partial List):

1. Non-Fraser parts
2. Overheating, oil issues, or contamination
3. Pre-ignition or detonation damage

4. Misuse or improper installation
5. Service items (filters, hoses, belts, etc.)
6. Racing, competition, or improper modifications
7. Electrolysis-related damage
8. Lack of required maintenance
9. Crankshaft damage from improper pressure
10. Unauthorized repairs
11. Fuel contamination
12. Incorrect oil or oil neglect
13. Transmission/clutch issues
14. Air filter neglect
15. Vibrational damage
16. Missed tune-ups
17. Alternate fuel use
18. Vehicles >11,000 lbs GVW (e.g., RVs)
19. Marine/racing use

Repair & Replacement Process

- Authorization required before any repair/replacement
- Unauthorized repairs will not be covered
- Products must be returned for inspection
- Fraser will pay return shipping (U.S. only)
- Replacements retain the original warranty duration

Labor Reimbursement

- Paid based on Mitchell(R) flat-rate schedule
- Reimbursement rate = Original installation rate (max as per plan)
- No coverage for DIY or unlicensed repairs

Parts Reimbursement

- Reimbursed at purchase price with proof
- 20% deduction without receipt
- Fluid/filter coverage valid only for first 2,000 miles
- Max parts reimbursement: \$25

Installation & Maintenance Requirements

Engines & Cylinder Heads

- Follow break-in procedures after installation
- 500-mile checkup (oil change, valve adjustment if needed)
- Synthetic oil not recommended before 5,000 miles

Automatic Transmissions

- No break-in required
- Check fluid every 100 miles during first 500 miles
- Follow OEM maintenance schedule

Warranty Registration

You must register your product to activate warranty coverage.
